Mid Year Comps and Performances

We are finalizing the last bits and pieces of our competition costumes, which we will wear for the first time at the *Dance Universe Competition* on 3<sup>rd</sup> June. **Please pay for and pick up your costumes next week.** They will need to be returned at the end of Term 4 when we finish all competitions and performances (not returned with all concert costumes).

Name:

Deposit: \$20 → please place cash in an envelope with your name on it

Hire: **Juniors \$60 Seniors \$65** (students keep shoes) **Opens \$60**

→ separate to deposit, may be cheque or cash in an envelope with your name on it

**Shoes**

- ★ **Juniors and Opens** need to wear **BLACK** dance sneakers with black laces.
- ★ **Seniors** Timberland boots



Please make sure all socks are black and invisible and laces are tied neatly and tucked away. Bra straps should be a matching colour/flesh, pinned and unseen. No jewelry or watches except stud earrings.

**Make up**

YES, YOU MUST USE MORE THAN NORMAL, you are under stage lights and you sweat during warm up.

Foundation, powder, eye shadow (natural colours), black eyeliner, black mascara.

Lipstick – you want a strong Red so that your smile can be seen ☺ You may use glitter gel on hair and face just make sure it's neat.



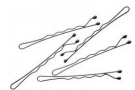
**Hair**

**MUST BE ABSOLUTELY SUPER NEAT.** All fringes must be super neat and short or gelled and pinned back. No wispy bits hanging out around the face or eyes. Any hair elastics or pins used need to match your hair colour.

**Juniors** – High ponytail at top back of head

**Seniors** – TBA

**Opens** – TBA



**All Ponytails or hair that is out** should be either neatly curled or straightened. **You WILL need to use gel, hairspray and bobby pins. Yes all three!**

Please read your note carefully and follow the instructions. If teachers have to fix performer's hair and make up beforehand it eats into the **ENTIRE** teams show preparation time. Do your part for the team and be ready ☺ If this is your first time doing Performance Hair & Make Up make sure you have a practice go before the event.

If you've followed the instructions you should now be looking like a fabulous dancer ready to light up the stage!
